RWPS has multiple expansion opportunities that will enable us to grow our clinical staff and serve more people. First, our satellite office just north of Dayton will be expanding in spring/summer 2026, and we are actively seeking LPCs to join our team. They will be supervised by [Alex Wallace, LPCC-S](#).

In addition, we are in the early stages of opening another satellite office elsewhere in the state of Ohio and are looking for a full-time mental health professional to lead this office and potentially others to join.

- Therapists (any license) skilled at working with trauma, couples, children, and/or families from a faith-informed perspective.

- Life-long learner with a passion for professional excellence and ongoing growth.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
